#### 7. Authorization:

I understand that New York Life has the right to require additional information and, if necessary, an examination by a physician. I ask New York Life to rely on all such statements made on this form, and any supplements to it, while considering this request. I also understand that the coverage afforded will be in consideration of the answers and statements set forth above.

AUTHORIZATION: I hereby authorize any licensed physician, medical practitioner, hospital, pharmacy, clinic or other medical or medically related facility, laboratory, insurance company or MIB, LLC ("MIB"), or other organization, institution or person, that has any records or knowledge of me or my health to release information, including prescription drug records, maintained by physicians, pharmacy benefit managers, and other sources of information to New York Life Insurance Company, its reinsurers, its subsidiaries or the plan administrator about the physical and mental health of any persons proposed for insurance, including significant history, findings, diagnosis and treatment, but excluding psychotherapy notes for the purpose of evaluating my application for insurance. Health information obtained will not be re-disclosed without my authorization unless permitted by law, in which case it may not be protected under federal privacy rules. For example, New York Life may be required to provide it to insurance, regulatory, or other government agencies. In this case, the information may no longer be protected by the rules governing your AUTHORIZATION.

A photocopy of this AUTHORIZATION and request form shall be as valid as the original. In all circumstances, my authorized agent or I may request a copy of this AUTHORIZATION. This AUTHORIZATION shall be valid for a period of 24 months from the date signed, unless sooner revoked. The AUTHORIZATION may be revoked at any time by sending written notice to New York Life Insurance Company. My revocation will not be effective to the extent that New York Life or any other person already has disclosed or collected information or taken other action in reliance on it, or to the extent that New York Life has a legal right to contest a claim under an insurance certificate or the certificate itself.

**RESIDENTS OF MD:** Any person who knowingly or willfully presents a false or fraudulent claim for payment of a loss or benefit or who knowingly or willfully presents false information in an application for insurance is guilty of a crime and may be subject to fines and confinement in prison.

**RESIDENTS OF NJ:** WARNING: Any person who includes any false or misleading information on an application for an insurance policy is subject to criminal and civil penalties.

**RESIDENTS OF OK:** WARNING: Any person who knowingly, and with intent to injure, defraud or deceive any insurer, makes any claim for the proceeds of an insurance policy containing any false, incomplete or misleading information is guilty of a felony.

### How New York Life Obtains Information and Underwrites Your Request For The Group Term Life Insurance

In this notice, references to "you" and "your" include any person proposed for insurance. Information regarding insurability will be treated as confidential. In considering whether the person(s) in your request for insurance qualify for insurance, we will rely on the medical information you provide, and on the information you AUTHORIZE us to obtain from your physician, other medical practitioners and facilities, other insurance companies to which you have applied for insurance and MIB, LLC ("MIB"). MIB is a not-for-profit organization of insurance companies, which operates an information exchange on behalf of its members. If you apply for life or health insurance coverage or a claim for benefits is submitted to an MIB member company, medical or non-medical information may be given to MIB and such information may then be furnished by MIB, upon request, to a member company.

Your AUTHORIZATION may be used for a period of 24 months from the date you signed the application for insurance, unless sooner revoked. The AUTHORIZATION may be revoked at any time by notifying New York Life in writing at the address provided. Your revocation will not be effective to the extent New York Life or any other person already has disclosed or collected information or taken other action in reliance on it, or to the extent that New York Life has a legal right to contest a claim under an insurance certificate or the certificate itself. The information New York Life obtains through your AUTHORIZATION may become subject to further disclosure. For example, New York Life may be required to provide it to insurance, regulatory or other government agencies. In this case, the information may no longer be protected by the rules governing your AUTHORIZATION.

MIB and other insurance companies may also furnish New York Life, its subsidiaries or the Plan Administrator with non-medical information (such as driving records, past convictions, hazardous sport or aviation activity, use of alcohol or drugs, and other application for insurance). The information provided may include information that may predate the time frame stated on the medical questions section, if any, on this application. This information may be used during the underwriting and claims processes, where permitted by law.

New York Life may release this information to the Plan Administrator, other insurance companies to which you may apply for life and health insurance, or to which a claim for benefits may be submitted and to others whom you authorize in writing. However, this will not be done in connection with test results concerning Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) or Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV). We may also make a brief report of your protected health information to MIB, but we will not disclose our underwriting decision.

New York Life will not disclose such information to anyone except those you authorize or where required or permitted by law. Information in our files may be seen by New York Life and Plan Administrator employees, but only on a "need to know" basis in considering your request. Upon receipt of all requested information, we will make a determination as to whether your request for insurance can be approved.

If we cannot provide the coverage you requested, we will tell you why. If you feel our information is inaccurate, you will be given a chance to correct or complete the information in our files. Upon written request to New York Life or MIB, you will be provided with non-medical information. Generally, medical information will be given either directly to the proposed insured or to a medical professional designated by the proposed insured. Your request is handled in accordance with the Federal Fair Credit Reporting Act procedures. If you question the accuracy of the information provided by MIB, you may contact MIB and seek a correction. Please include your full name, date of birth and address.

<sup>1</sup>**PROTECTED PERSON** means a victim of domestic abuse; who has notified us that he/she is or has been a victim of domestic abuse; and who is an insured or prospective insured person.

<sup>2</sup>CONFIDENTIAL ABUSE INFORMATION means information about: acts of domestic abuse or abuse status; the work or home address or telephone number of a victim of domestic abuse; or the status of an applicant or insured family member, employer or associate of a victim of domestic abuse or a person with whom the applicant or insured is known to have a direct, close, personal, family or abuse-related relationship.

#### Who Is Eligible?

All AJLI members under age 60 are eligible to apply for this coverage. If applying for coverage for yourself, you can apply for your lawful spouse/domestic partner, also under age 60, for an amount not exceeding yours. Your children ages 6 months to 25 years are each eligible for \$2,500 of life insurance. Children 15 days to 6 months may be insured for \$1,000 each. Just \$0.60 a month covers all children no matter how many.

The Living Benefit or "accelerated death benefit" is designed to provide members with the option to have a portion of a terminally ill insured's life insurance benefit paid while he/she is still alive.

The money received under this feature can be used however you see fit. For example, it can help pay medical bills and other outstanding debts and financial obligations...it can help you keep your savings and assets intact...it can help you maintain your quality of living.

To qualify for this benefit, a person must be insured under this coverage and diagnosed as having a life expectancy of 12 months or less. Proof of terminal illness will consist of a statement from a doctor and any other medical information New York Life Insurance Company believes necessary to confirm the person's status.

You can request payment equal to 50% of a qualified terminally ill person's in force coverage. The request must be made at least 12 months prior to that person's scheduled coverage termination age, and the amount payable after the insured's death will be reduced by this payment. (Premium contributions will not be reduced.)

If a scheduled reduction will occur within one year of the date the advance payment will be made, the benefit payable will be 50% of the reduced coverage. Note: An insured will be eligible for only one terminal illness benefit during his/her lifetime.

Please note that the receipt of this benefit may affect your eligibility for public assistance programs and may be taxable. You may wish to consult the appropriate social services agency and a qualified tax advisor about how this may affect your personal situation.

The total amount of coverage for an individual insured under this Policy issued by New York Life Insurance Company to the Trustee of the Life Insurance for Members of the AJLI may not exceed \$1,000,000. The total amount of coverage for an individual may have under all group life insurance policies underwritten by New York Life Insurance Company may not exceed \$2,000,000.

#### **Exclusions**

Your AJLI Group Term Life Insurance provides benefits for death from any cause (except suicide or intentionally self-inflicted injury during the first two years your coverage is in force) ... at any time ... in any place throughout the world. If death is the result of suicide or intentionally self-inflicted injury within 2 years from the date his insurance takes effect, the Insurance Company's liability will be limited to the premiums paid. If a person's age, sex or any other data is misstated, the correct data will be used to determine if insurance is in force. If insurance is in force, the premium and/or benefits will be adjusted according to the facts.

#### Your Choice of Beneficiary

You may select any person, persons, trust or other legal entity as your beneficiary. If, at the time of your death, there are no surviving beneficiaries, benefits will be paid to the executor or administrator of your estate, or at the option of New York Life, to the surviving relatives in the following order of survival: spouse; children equally; parents equally; or brothers and sisters equally.

#### Premiums Are Waived If You're Totally Disabled

If you become totally disabled before age 60, and remain so disabled for nine months or longer, your insurance will be continued as long as you remain totally disabled – for both you and your insured family members – without additional premium contributions. The amount continued will be based on the options under which you and your dependents were insured at the time your disability began, subject to the scheduled decreases. You may be asked to provide evidence of your continued total disability from time to time.

#### When Coverage Ends

Your insurance will continue automatically until the policy anniversary date coinciding with or next following your your insured spouse's 100<sup>th</sup> birthday (for children, their 25<sup>th</sup> birthday), as long as you pay your premium when due, remain an AJLI member, the Group Policy remains in force and insurance does not end for your class. Dependent's insurance will continue until your insurance ends under the group policy, the group policy is changed to end dependents' life insurance, the person ceases to be a dependent or premium is not paid for the dependent when due. If you die, your spouse and dependent children who were insured under the group policy immediately prior to your death may continue to be insured, subject to the terms and conditions of the group policy.

#### **Coverage at Later Ages**

On your premium due date coinciding with or next following the date you attain ages 45, 60, 65, 70, and 75, your amount of life insurance will be limited to the lesser of the amount in effect on such date, or these stated amounts:

#### Can my Insurance Be Cancelled?

Your insurance cannot be cancelled as long as you pay your premium when due, maintain your AJLI membership, are under age 100, all insureds remain eligible, and the group policy remains in force.

#### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

You and your dependents will become insured on the date specified by New York Life Insurance Company provided the initial premium contribution has been paid paid, satisfactory evidence of insurability has been submitted and any person to be insured is actively performing the normal activities of a person in good health of like age [NC residents: a person of like age] on the date of approval. Any person who is not performing his/her normal daily activities as required will not become insured until the day he/she is performing such activities provided such date is within three months of the date insurance would have been effective, and the person is still eligible. (Payment of a premium contribution for insurance does not mean there is any coverage in force before the effective date as specified by New York Life Insurance Company.)

#### **CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE**

This brochure contains only a brief description of some of the principal provisions and features. The complete terms and conditions are set forth in the group policy issued by New York Life Insurance Company to the Association of Junior Leagues International, Inc.

When you become insured, you will be sent a Certificate of Insurance summarizing your benefits under the Policy.

#### **30-DAY FREE LOOK**

If you're not completely satisfied with the terms of your Certificate of Insurance, you may return it, without claim, within 30 days. Your coverage will be invalidated, and you will be sent a full refund, no questions asked!

#### RENEWAL PAYMENTS AND CLAIMS

Once your application is approved, you will have a 31-day grace period for your payment of renewal premium contribution. When you want to submit a claim, call or write the Administrator for claim forms.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

#### **Consider Your Eligibility**
